
CLAIM: 15 tests were eliminated **REALITY:** ONLY 4 tests were eliminated (=15 test administrations)

**CLAIM:** There are only 10 districtmandated standardized tests **REALITY:** These 10 tests are administered more than 150 times

CLAIM: There are only 10 districtmandated standardized tests **REALITY:** There are at least 11 other district-wide tests\*\* being administered more than 100 times. (Three are technically optional but are administered at the vast majority of schools.) The newly required Common Core Quarterly Benchmark tasks alone compose around 60 administrations.

> **CPS ACKNOWLEDGES** 10 TESTS = 150 ADMINISTRATIONS **REMAINING**

These counts underestimate total testing taking place. Most schools use more than these 21 tests. Many elementary students take standardized tests biweekly ("progress monitoring"). In Level 3 schools **CPS** mandates 30 sight-word assessments for K-2. 90 administrations not even on this chart!
